Respect: Treat all teammates, coaches, opponents, and officials with respect, both on and off the field.

Sportsmanship: Display good sportsmanship at all times, regardless of the outcome of the game. Shake hands with opponents after the game and congratulate them on their efforts.

Commitment: Show dedication and commitment to the team by attending practices, games, and team events. Notify the coach in advance if unable to attend.

Punctuality: Arrive on time for practices and games. Being punctual shows respect for your coaches and teammates' time and helps maintain a smooth flow of activities.

Effort and Attitude: Give your best effort in every practice and game. Maintain a positive attitude and support your teammates, even in challenging situations.

Safety: Follow all safety guidelines and instructions provided by coaches. Be mindful of the safety of yourself and others during games and practices.

Equipment and Facilities: Treat all team equipment, facilities, and uniforms with care and respect. Report any damages or issues promptly to the coach.

Communication: Communicate openly and respectfully with coaches and teammates. Express your thoughts and concerns in a constructive manner.

Personal Conduct: Avoid behavior that may bring discredit to yourself or the team, including the use of inappropriate language, aggressive behavior, discriminating behavior, theft, vandalism, or substance abuse.

Compliance: Adhere to all league rules and regulations, as well as any additional guidelines established by the board or coaching staff.

 Players are expected to be at all activities that you've committed to, ready to play with all equipment needed. If a player is unable to attend a team activity, the player is expected to let the coach or team manager know in advance. Unexcused absences may cause a loss of playing time.

 Players play in games at the sole direction of the coach. Players are not guaranteed playing time; unless specified by league rules. Players play at positions assigned at the sole discretion of the coach. Players should not demand to play or not to play certain positions. You are playing competitively and the coach will play you where it is best for the team and your individual development.

 Not having your registration fees paid on time may have an impact on the eligibility of players. It is important to ensure that fees are promptly settled to avoid any potential issues regarding player participation. Delta Baseball and Softball has implemented a strict no refund policy. This policy applies to all payments made, including fundraisers and regular season registration fees. Once a payment has been made, it is non-refundable. We kindly request everyone carefully consider making financial commitments before making any payments.

Delta has a zero-tolerance policy that reserves the right to expel any member of Delta Baseball and Softball at any time.
